Rachael Lechman, Class of '99, is "absolutely thrilled that the Lord has called her to be the Middle School Girls' Bible teacher at CCS."

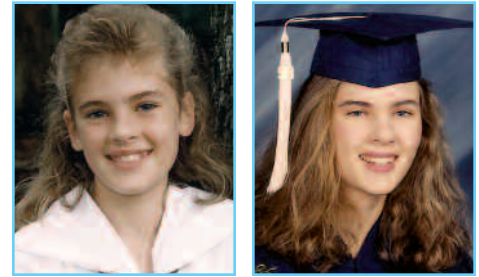

- Rachael's senior class trip was to Hawaii!



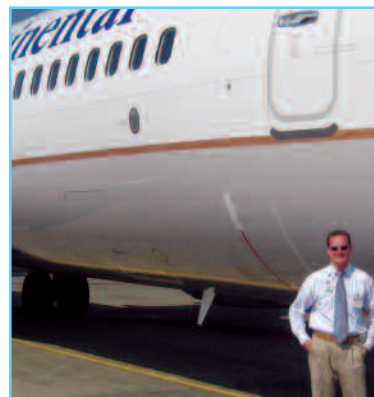
Race for the Cure
