Fine Arts

Middle School Art

- Students learn basic drawing and use media such as pencil, pastel, pen ink. Projects include still life to learn shape and form and line techniques.

High School Art Projects

- Bible for Art students or "B-Art" is a new program in which students study God's word and illustrate concepts and themes they encounter.
- Art students have the opportunity to work in a variety of media like this watercolor project (at right) which can be entered in various art competitions throughout the year (TAPPS)



Drama - Debate - Speech

Classes for students in sixth grade through twelfth grade are available for the students who love to express themselves through the art of acting, debate, and/or speech!

- Sixth grade drama offers the basics in theatre and includes the opportunity to help produce a musical.
- Seventh and eighth grade drama students focus on memory techniques, character development, and impromptu.
- High school drama class offers the opportunity to study the history of drama and stage basics.
- Drama II is for the theatrical student. Admittance to this class is by teacher approval.
- Drama Club is led by local playwright and director Terri Welch, and students perform one play a year.
- Debate students will represent CCS at TAPPS competition in the areas of persuasive speaking and original oratory.
- Speech class is devoted to helping students make the most of each opportunity they are given to speak in front of others.



Music is a powerful tool created by God. Man has always had the choice to use music to glorify God or himself. CCS offers each student the opportunity to praise God through music.

Choir Performances/Competition

Each year, secondary choir students perform in chapel, at athletic events, for special ceremonies at school, and in the community. In the spring, both high school choirs, soloists, and CCS ensemble groups participate in TAPPS competitions (District, Regional and State). In addition, the Music Department hosts a Spring Concert, featuring all of the music from the TAPPS Competition.

- Sixth grade music students experience performance and various aspects of music theory and singing.
- Middle School Girls' Ensemble learns correct and healthy vocal techniques, the aspects of music theory, and sight-singing.
- The High School Choir students learn correct vocal technique, sight-singing methods, and various styles of music.
- The Chamber Choir is an auditioned group composed of tenth-twelfth grade students. This select choir practices correct vocal technique, sight-singing methods, and challenging repertoire.

Band

- Worship Band members lead worship during weekly chapel services at school. These students understand the responsibility of being a "lead worshipper," realizing that the example they set each day is as important as how they lead each Wednesday.
- The Jazz Band includes musicians who are seeking to gain experience and a higher level of proficiency.
