

Senior Girls (Grade 12) Dress Code Guidelines 2011-2012

The school's dress code is designed to facilitate an environment that helps the school achieve its primary goal - building Christian character and academic competence. The cooperation of the student and the parent is necessary in maintaining the standards of the school's dress code. Dress code violations will be recorded, and repeated violations will result in appropriate disciplinary action. Coming to school each day with clothing in compliance with the dress code is a responsibility of both the student and the parent.

- **Logos/Monograms:** Only CCS logos or wording are allowed on garments (available from Parker, Lands' End, CCS Booster Club, and other school organizations).
- **Polos/Dress Shirts/T-shirts:** All polos, dress shirts, and t-shirts may be worn tucked or un-tucked. Shirts must be of appropriate size, properly buttoned and must be long enough to avoid midriff or undergarments from showing.
 - **Monday through Thursday:** Striped or solid polos or dress shirts of any color may be worn.
 - **Friday:** In addition to other approved clothing, CCS Spirit Wear, approved CCS class/organization polos and t-shirts may be worn.
- **Skirts/Pants/Shorts/Jeans:**
 - **Monday through Thursday:** Solid navy or khaki skirts, pants and shorts are to be worn.
 - **Friday:** In addition to other approved clothing, denim jeans may be worn on Fridays only. Jeans are to be blue - no other colors are allowed. "Skinny jeans" or overly baggy jeans are not allowed.
- **Skirts** should not have a slit higher than the knee. Skirts must be worn at the knee or below, and may not be rolled at the waist. Skorts not allowed.
- **Pants/Shorts/Jeans** should not be too tight or too loose. Clothing should not allow undergarments to be visible. Low rise garments are not permitted nor is "sagging" allowed. Pants and jeans may not be cut to fit over shoes, and may not have holes, rips or frays. Shorts must not be shorter than two inches above the knee and not be longer than the bottom of the knee. No cargo/crop/gauchos/overalls/carpenter, Dickie or capri style pants/jeans.
- **Belts:** A belt must be worn with garments that have belt loops when a shirt is worn tucked in, when the belt loops are easily seen, or when needed to ensure proper fit of shorts or pants even when worn with an un-tucked shirt. Belts must be solid black, brown, navy blue or tan in color with a regular "D-ring" or other standard buckle (no "logo" buckles). Belts with studs or spikes are not allowed.
- **Shoes:** Athletic or casual shoes in good condition should be worn each day. Shoes with laces must be tied at all times. Boots, flip flops, sandals and slippers are not allowed.
- **Socks: Monday – Thursday:** If socks are worn, they must be solid navy blue, black, white or khaki color. **Friday:** If socks are worn, they may be any solid color.
- **Undershirts:** Only solid white undershirts may be worn underneath polo/t-shirts and must not stick out below the bottom of the uniform shirt. Long sleeve undershirts/turtlenecks may only be worn under long sleeve polos/t-shirts.
- **Underwear** should not be visible at any time. Modesty is expected. (Example: Girls are to wear solid white shells under white polos and t-shirts to avoid the visibility of undergarments.)
- **Outerwear:**
 - Any CCS sweatshirts, jackets, or sweaters purchased from the CCS Spirit Store are permitted at school and in classrooms.
 - Non-CCS Spirit Store sweatshirts, zip or button front jackets, sweaters or sweater vests that are a solid color are permitted at school and in classrooms. No wording or logos are allowed, except the CCS logo.
 - All outerwear garments must be neat in appearance, appropriately sized and worn over approved CCS uniform shirts or clothing. Outerwear is to be completely on or off, and not tied around the waist. Garments may have hoods, but hoods may not be worn while inside any buildings.
 - Heavy coats may be worn to and from school, but should be kept in locker during school hours.
- **Co-curricular:** Students attending school-sponsored functions, including home and away activities, are to use the following guidelines for non-uniform attire: 1) Shorts, shirts and skirts must reflect a biblical standard of modesty and appropriateness; 2) No clothes that promote activities/values contrary to school policies and Christian principles; 3) Swimsuits must be modest. No two-piece suits or semi-transparent suits are permitted; 4) The administration may allow or require special clothing to be worn as may be needed or appropriate for a particular field trip or special event; and 5) Underwear should not be visible at any time.
- **Grooming:** Make-up and nail polish must be tasteful. Tattoos/body writings are not permitted. Body piercing is limited to one earring per ear.
- **Hair:** Hair must be neatly groomed at all times and should not cover the eyes. It should be worn in a manner that is not a distraction to the student or others around her (this includes any extreme haircuts and/or color). No sunglasses, hats, bandanas, hoodies, or items should be worn on head indoors.
