



## **Volunteers In Partnership**

### **Program Overview 2011-2012**

**Admissions-** Help spread the news about CCS! Our Admissions department is seeking volunteers to deliver information about CCS to local pre-schools. This will require approximately two hours per month.

Grandparents'/Special Friends day is an exciting time for our elementary students as they share with their special guests, a day planned just for them. Volunteers are needed in various areas such as, food preparation, set-up, decorations, and clean-up.

**Board Appreciation** - CCS Board members volunteer their time and expertise to further the ministry of our school. They usually meet on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month at 6:30 p.m. and usually come directly from work. Therefore, we love to bless these faithful servants by providing dinner for them before their meeting begins. Individuals are needed to provide food, drinks, and occasional set-up.

**Box Top Fundraiser** – This program offers a simple and fun way for families to “earn” cash for CCS. Volunteers are needed periodically to help collect/and or count the box tops.

**Classroom/Grade Level Volunteers** - Each year, our teachers rely heavily on volunteers to assist with a variety of needs including parties, field trips, competitions, service projects, and much more. Each elementary teacher distributes a volunteer form specific to his/her classroom needs. Volunteer forms are distributed for middle school and high school needs by teachers. Be sure to let your child's teacher(s) know how you can help. This year, middle-school would like to incorporate room-parents. Each grade level will need 2-4 room parents.

**Elementary Lunchroom Program** – Lunch is one of the most important and fun times of a student's day. Volunteers help make this a special time for both teachers and lunchroom aides. Assistance is needed Monday mornings to help bake cookies and Wednesday mornings to help bake brownies.

**Faculty/Staff Appreciation** - The goal of this ministry is to love and bless our teachers and staff. One day a month is designated as faculty/staff appreciation day to provide lunch, snacks, and encouragement to the employees at CCS. In December, monetary gifts are collected to bless the faculty/staff during the Christmas season. Volunteers are needed to help with communication and distributing gifts. In May, volunteers host a staff/faculty appreciation week and your help is needed to let CCS employees know just how much they are loved! This week, numerous volunteer opportunities are available.

**Junior Achievement Coordinator** -We are looking for someone with an enthusiastic attitude and willingness to work with volunteers to better prepare students for their future. Junior Achievement is a non-profit organization established in 1954. The organization's purpose is "to educate and inspire young people to value free enterprise, understand business and economics, and be better prepared for the workforce. The coordinator would be responsible for working with the elementary room mom coordinator to find parent volunteers to teach 45 minutes per week for five weeks. A brief overview meeting will be held to distribute teaching materials.

**Library Assistance** - Library time is an important time for both our elementary and secondary students each week. Volunteers are needed in any capacity to assist our librarian, Mrs. Carthey, by checking in and shelving returned books. The annual book fair is a time our students look forward to and volunteers are needed to help set-up and work during this time.

**Prayer Warrior Team** - The most powerful activity we can participate in is prayer, so we encourage you to intercede for our school, students, and community by effectively, protectively, and strategically praying. Please join others in praying for CCS.

**Special Events** – CCS students participate throughout the year in various academic and extracurricular competitions. Volunteers are needed to help judge contests, drive to competitions, and/or use their organizational skills to help with the details involved in the competition process.

**Spirit Store** – Help families of CCS show their pride! Volunteers are needed on special occasions such as Blue and White night and Homecoming, to help set-up, work the booth, and clean-up.

**VIP Spirit Button Fundraiser** - New to CCS this year! The proceeds from sales will help support the VIP program. A team of volunteers will be needed to work along with the coordinator on things such as assembling the buttons and delivering them on campus.
