

WARRIOR ZEAL - Homecoming 2009



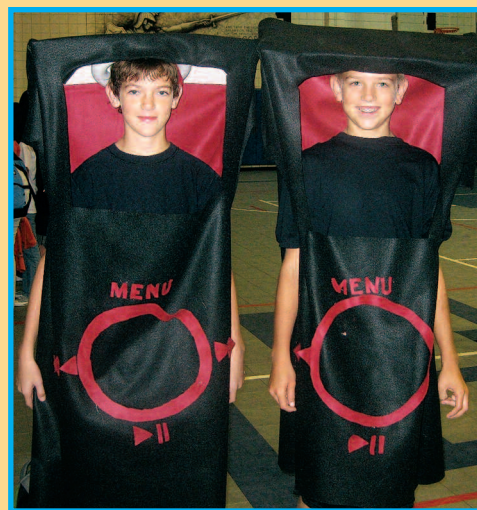
