

Section E1 – Dress Code Policies: Secondary

E1.1 Secondary Girls (Grades 6-12) Dress Code Guidelines

The school's dress code is designed to a) promote the decorum and dignity of our academic mission, b) promote unity of purpose within the student body and c) support biblical principles of modesty and distinction of genders. Supporting the school and coming to school each day with clothing in compliance with the dress code is a responsibility of both the student and the parent. Dress code violations will be recorded, and repeated violations will result in appropriate disciplinary action.

- FlynnO'Hara approved uniforms* - Navy, light blue or white polos with interlocking CC logo worn with approved uniform skirts, pants, skorts or shorts. - Chapel: navy blue polo with interlocking CC logo worn with approved uniform skirts, pants, skorts or shorts. Outerwear must be navy. - Outerwear worn in classrooms: any approved CCS outerwear that is navy, Columbia blue, white or gray. ***Land's End Uniforms:** CCS Land's End uniforms that comply with current dress code standards and are in good condition may continue to be worn for the 2026-2027 school year.

Logos/Monograms: Only CCS logos/wording are allowed on garments (available from Flynn O'Hara, Warrior Warehouse and other school organizations).

Polos/T-shirts: All polos and t-shirts may be worn tucked or untucked. Shirts must be of appropriate size, properly buttoned and must be long enough to avoid midriff or undergarments from showing. T-shirts may not be tied up.

- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday:** Solid navy, light blue or white polos with interlocking CC logo purchased from FlynnO'Hara must be worn.
- Wednesday:** Chapel wear is a navy polo.
- Friday:** In addition to approved uniforms, CCS-approved spirit wear and CCS class/organization shirts issued by the school may be worn.

Skirts/Pants/Shorts/Jeans:

- Monday through Thursday:** Solid navy, khaki or "CCS plaid" skirts, pants and shorts purchased from approved lists at FlynnO'Hara are to be worn.
- Friday:** In addition to approved uniforms, denim jeans may be worn on Fridays only. Jeans are to be blue - no other colors are allowed. Overly tight or overly baggy jeans are not allowed. Jeans may not be cut to fit over shoes, and may not have holes, rips or frays. No cargo/gauchos/overalls, carpenter-style pants/jeans or jeggings.

Skirts and shorts must be no shorter than three inches above the crease at the back of the knee and may not be rolled at the waist. All pants/shorts/jeans should not be too tight nor too loose. Clothing should not allow undergarments to be visible. Low-rise garments are not permitted nor is "sagging" allowed. Due to bleacher seating and other practical considerations of the school environment, girls must wear shorts, spandex, leggings or tights under their uniform skirts. Leggings may be black or navy.

Belts: A belt must be worn with garments that have belt loops when a shirt is worn tucked in, when the belt loops are easily seen, or when needed to ensure proper fit of shorts or pants even when worn with an untucked shirt. Belts must be solid black, brown, navy blue or tan in color with a regular "D-ring" or other standard buckle (no "logo" buckles). Belts with studs or spikes are not allowed.

Shoes: Athletic or casual shoes in good condition and correctly fitted should be worn each day. Shoes with laces or lace eyelets must be tied at all times. Western boots (cowboy or ropers) may be worn with long pants. No other styles of boots are allowed. Pants and jeans may not be tucked into boots. Flip-flops, sandals and slippers are not allowed.

Socks: If socks are worn, acceptable colors are white, navy blue, gray, black or Columbia blue. No images or wording allowed other than manufacturer's marks or logos.

Undershirts: Solid white or navy undershirts may be worn underneath polos and t-shirts and should not extend below the bottom of a shirt.

Undergarments should not be visible at any time. Modesty is expected. (Example: Girls are to wear solid white shells under white polos and t-shirts to avoid the visibility of undergarments.)

Outerwear: Students may wear CCS-approved outerwear. This includes outerwear purchased via a uniform provider or in the Warrior Warehouse that is navy, Columbia blue, white or gray. Outerwear provided by CCS athletics is also allowed. Sweatshirts, hoodies, cage jackets or jackets in navy, Columbia blue, white or gray may be worn. Hoods may not be worn in buildings. All outerwear garments must be neat in appearance, appropriately sized and worn over approved CCS uniform shirts or clothing. Heavy coats may be worn to and from school and at recess but may not be worn inside buildings. Only navy outerwear may be worn on chapel days.

Co-Curricular: Students attending school-sponsored functions, including home and away activities, are to wear clothing that is appropriate for the setting and activity, and that promotes biblical standards of dignity and modesty. The following guidelines, for non-uniform attire not already described above, are to be followed: 1) Shirts/tops must cover midriff when sitting or raising arms. Shirts should not be sheer, overly tight or have a low neckline without an appropriate layer of clothing underneath; shirts/tops should also not be strapless nor have straps less than one inch wide; 2) Dresses should not be sheer, overly tight or have a low neckline without an appropriate layer of clothing underneath, and skirt length must be no higher, all the way around, than three inches above the crease at the back of the knee. They should not be strapless nor have straps less than one inch wide; 3) Rompers must comply with guidelines for shirts and length guidelines for dresses; 4) Yoga pants may only be worn with a shirt that has a length all the way around that is within ½ inch of the tip of the forefinger when arms are at the side; 5) Shorts should be no shorter than athletic shorts issued by the school, which means generally of a length that is within ½ inch of the tip of the forefinger when arms are at the side. Tightness of fit should allow at least ½ inch of fabric to be pinched at the side. Hem of shorts should be visible below shirt or jacket top. Yoga, spandex or compression shorts may only be worn under shorts described above in this paragraph; 6) No clothing that promotes activities/values contrary to school policies and Christian principles; 7) Undergarments should not be visible at any time; 8) The administration may allow or require special clothing to be worn as may be needed or appropriate for a particular field trip or special event.

Grooming/Accessories: Makeup and nail polish must be tasteful. Tattoos/body writings are not permitted. Body piercing is limited to two earrings in the outer ear. No gauges, chains, bars or tissue-expanding apparatus are allowed. A scarf with CCS colors (navy blue, light blue and white) may be worn.

Hair: Hair must be neatly groomed at all times and should not cover the eyes. It should be worn in a manner that is not a distraction to the student or others around her (this includes any extreme haircuts and/or extreme or unnatural color). No sunglasses, hats, bandanas, hoodies or other distracting items should be worn on head indoors.

E1.2 Secondary Boys (Grades 6-12) Dress Code Guidelines

The school's dress code is designed to help the school a) promote the decorum and dignity of our academic mission, b) promote unity of purpose within the student body and c) support biblical principles of modesty and distinction of genders. Supporting the school and coming to school each day with clothing in compliance with the dress code is a responsibility of both the student and the parent. Dress code violations will be recorded, and repeated violations will result in appropriate disciplinary action.

***Land's End Uniforms:** CCS Land's End uniforms that comply with current dress code standards and are in good condition may continue to be worn for the 2026-2027 school year.

Logos/Monograms: Only CCS logos/wording are allowed on garments (available from FlynnO'Hara, Warrior Warehouse and other school organizations).

Polos/T-shirts: All polos and t-shirts may be worn tucked or untucked. Shirts must be of appropriate size, properly buttoned and must be long enough to avoid midriff or undergarments from showing.

- **Monday, Tuesday, Thursday:** Solid navy, light blue or white polos purchased with interlocking CC logo from FlynnO'Hara must be worn.
- **Wednesday:** Chapel wear is a navy polo.
- **Friday:** In addition to approved uniforms, CCS approved spirit wear and CCS class/organization shirts issued by the school may be worn.

Pants/Shorts/Jeans:

- **Monday through Thursday:** Solid navy or khaki pants and shorts purchased from FlynnO'Hara are to be worn.
- **Friday:** In addition to approved uniforms, denim jeans may be worn on Fridays only. Jeans are to be blue - no other colors are allowed. Overly tight or overly baggy jeans are not allowed. Jeans may not have holes, frays or rips.

All pants/shorts/jeans should not be too tight nor too loose. Clothing should not allow undergarments to be visible. Low-rise garments are not permitted nor is "sagging" allowed. Pants and jeans may not be cut to fit over shoes, and may not have holes, rips or frays. Shorts must not be shorter than three inches above the crease at the back of the knee and not be longer than the bottom of the knee. No cargo/crop/carpenter or cargo style pants/jeans.

Belts: A belt must be worn with garments that have belt loops when a shirt is worn tucked in, when the belt loops are easily seen or when needed to ensure proper fit of shorts or pants even when worn with an untucked shirt. Belts must be solid black, brown, navy blue or tan in color with a regular "D-ring" or other standard buckle (no "logo" buckles). Belts with studs or spikes are not allowed.

Shoes: Athletic or casual shoes in good condition and correctly fitted should be worn each day. Shoes with laces or lace eyelets must be tied at all times. Western boots (cowboy or ropers) may be worn with long pants. No other styles of boots are allowed. Pants and jeans may not be tucked into boots. Flip-flops, sandals and slippers are not allowed.

Socks: If socks are worn, socks must be matching and visible at the top of the shoe. Acceptable sock colors are white, navy blue, gray, black or Columbia blue. No images or wording allowed other than manufacturer's marks or logos.

Undershirts: Solid white or navy undershirts may be worn under polos and t-shirts and should not extend below the bottom of a shirt.

Outerwear: Students may wear CCS-approved outerwear. This includes outerwear purchased via a uniform provider or in the Warrior Warehouse that is navy, Columbia blue, white or gray. Outerwear provided by CCS athletics is also allowed. Sweatshirts, hoodies, cage jackets or jackets in navy, Columbia blue, white or gray may be worn. Hoods may not be worn in buildings. All outerwear garments must be neat in appearance, appropriately sized and worn over approved CCS uniform shirts or clothing. Heavy coats may be worn to and from school and at recess but may not be worn inside buildings. Only navy outerwear may be worn on chapel days.

Co-Curricular: Students attending school-sponsored functions, including home and away activities, are to use the following guidelines for non-uniform attire: 1) Unless a coach or faculty member gives permission for particular games or activities, boys are not permitted to wear sleeveless shirts, tank tops or see-through/mesh clothing and are expected to wear a shirt; 2) No clothing is allowed that promotes activities/things contrary to school policies and Christian values; 3) The administration may allow or require special clothing to be worn as may be needed or appropriate for a particular field trip or special event.

Grooming: No beards or mustaches are permitted. Sideburns may be to the tip of the ear lobe. Boys should come to school clean-shaven each day. Boys are not permitted to body pierce, tattoo, wear make-up or nail polish, body-write or wear pierced or clip-on jewelry (earrings, nose rings, etc.).

Hair: Hair must be neatly groomed at all times. It should be worn in a manner that is not a distraction to the student or others around him (this includes mohawks or any other extreme haircuts and/or haircuts with unnatural or extreme color contrasts). Hair should be cut above the eyebrows, ears, and off the shirt collar in the back. Hairstyles that have lengths which cause the student to wet, clip, fold, tie, or gel the hair to gain compliance are not allowed.

Head Gear: No head coverings of any kind (hats, bandanas, hoodies, towels, etc.) are permitted to be worn inside buildings. No combs, sunglasses or picks are to be worn in hair or on the head.

E2.1 Elementary Girls (Grades TK-5) Dress Code Guidelines

The school's dress code is designed to a) promote the decorum and dignity of our academic mission, b) promote unity of purpose within the student body and c) support biblical principles of modesty and distinction of genders. Supporting the school and coming to school each day with clothing in compliance with the dress code is a responsibility of both the student and the parent. Logos/Monograms: Only CCS logos/wording are allowed on garments (available from FlynnO'Hara, Warrior Warehouse and other school organizations).

Blouses/Polos/T-shirts: All blouses/polos/t-shirts may be worn tucked or untucked. Shirts must be of appropriate size, properly buttoned and must be long enough to avoid midriff or undergarments from showing.

- **Monday, Tuesday, Thursday:** Solid navy, light blue or white blouses/polos with interlocking CC logo purchased from FlynnO'Hara must be worn.
- **Chapel (usually Wednesdays):** Navy blue polo with interlocking CC logo purchased from FlynnO'Hara with uniform pants/skirts/shorts/skorts/jumpers must be worn. Students' outerwear must be approved CCS outerwear that is navy.
- **Friday:** In addition to approved uniforms, CCS approved spirit wear may be worn.

Skirts/Pants/Skorts/Jumpers/Shorts:

- **Monday through Thursday:** Solid navy, khaki or "CCS plaid" skirts, pants and shorts purchased from approved lists at FlynnO'Hara are to be worn.
- **Friday:** In addition to approved uniforms, denim jeans, shorts or skirts may be worn on Fridays only. Jeans are to be blue - no other colors are allowed. "Skinny jeans" or overly baggy jeans are not allowed.

Skirts: Skirts must be no shorter than three inches above the crease at the back of the knee. Navy shorts must be worn underneath garment. **Jumpers:** Must be no shorter than three inches above the crease at the back of the knee. Navy shorts must be worn underneath garment.

Skorts: Must be no shorter than three inches above the crease at the back of the knee. Due to stadium seating, playground equipment, and stairs, and other practical considerations of the school environment, girls must wear navy shorts, leggings, or tights under their uniform skirt.

Pants/Shorts/Jeans: Pants/shorts/jeans should not be too tight nor too loose. Clothing should not allow undergarments to be visible. Low-rise garments are not permitted nor is "sagging" allowed. Pants and jeans may not be cut to fit over shoes, and may not have holes, rips or frays, multi-colored designs, or embellishments. Shorts must be no shorter than three inches above the crease at the back of the knee. No cargo/crop/gauchos/overalls/carpenter or pants/jeans may be worn.

Socks: Socks must be worn with shoes. Acceptable sock colors are white, navy blue, gray, black or Columbia blue. No images or wording other than manufacturer's marks or logos. Socks may be purchased from retailer of choice.

Tights/Leggings: Navy leggings or tights may be worn under uniforms skirts or jumpers that are purchased from FlynnO'Hara. Leggings must have a straight-leg silhouette and may not be flared or bootcut.

Belts: A belt must be worn with garments that have belt loops when a shirt is worn tucked in, when the belt loops are easily seen or when needed to ensure proper fit of shorts or pants even when worn with an untucked shirt. Belts must be solid black, brown, navy blue or tan in color with a regular "D-ring" or other standard buckle (no "logo" buckles). Belts with studs or spikes are not allowed.

Shoes: Athletic or casual shoes, in good condition and properly fitted, should be worn each day. Shoes with laces or lace eyelets must be tied at all times. Flip-flops, sandals, slippers, and boots are not allowed.

Undershirts: Solid white or navy undershirts may be worn under polos and t-shirts and should not extend below the bottom of a shirt nor extend beyond the shirt sleeve.

Undergarments: Should not be visible at any time. Modesty is expected. (Example: Girls are to wear solid white shells under white polos and t-shirts to avoid the visibility of undergarments.)

Outerwear: Students may wear CCS-approved outerwear. This includes outerwear purchased via a uniform provider or in the Warrior Warehouse that is navy, Columbia blue, white or gray. Outerwear provided by CCS athletics is also allowed. Sweatshirts, hoodies, cage jackets or jackets in navy, Columbia blue, white or gray may be worn. Hoods may not be worn in buildings. All outerwear garments must be neat in appearance, appropriately sized and worn over approved CCS uniform shirts or clothing. Heavy coats may be worn to and from school and at recess but may not be worn inside buildings. Only navy outerwear may be worn on chapel days.

(Yoga pants may not be worn without dress-code length shorts over them to school day events such as Run-4-Fun, Tribal Competition, etc.); 5) Shorts should be no shorter than athletic shorts issued by the school, which means generally of a length that is within ½ inch of the tip of the forefinger when arms are at the side. Tightness of fit should allow at least ½ inch of fabric to be pinched at the side. Hem of shorts should be visible below shirt or jacket top. Yoga, spandex or compression shorts may only be worn under shorts described above in this paragraph; 6) No clothing that promotes activities/values contrary to school policies and Christian principles; 7) Undergarments should not be visible at any time; 8) The administration may allow or require special clothing to be worn as may be needed or appropriate for a particular field trip or special event.

Grooming: Make-up (other than lip gloss) should not be worn by students prior to 6th grade. Nail polish must be tasteful. Artificial nails are not permitted in grades TK-5. Artificial tattoos/body writings are not permitted. Body piercing is limited to one earring per ear. No gauges, chains, bars or tissue-expanding apparatus are allowed.

Hair: Hair must be neatly groomed at all times and should not cover the eyes. It should be worn in a manner that is not a distraction to the student or others around her (this includes any extreme haircuts and/or extreme or unnatural color). No sunglasses, hats, bandanas, hoodies or other distracting items should be worn on head indoors.

Supporting the school and coming to school each day with clothing in compliance with the dress code is a responsibility of both the student and the parent. Dress code violations will be recorded, and repeated violations will result in appropriate disciplinary action.

- **Monday, Tuesday, Thursday:** Solid navy, light blue or white polos purchased with interlocking CC logo from FlynnO'Hara must be worn.
- **Chapel (usually Wednesdays):** Navy blue polo with interlocking CC logo purchased from FlynnO'Hara with uniform pants or shorts must be worn. Students' outerwear must be approved CCS outerwear that is navy.
- **Friday:** In addition to approved uniforms, CCS approved spirit wear may be worn. Students' outerwear can be non-standard colors, as long as it is approved CCS outerwear.

Pants/Shorts/Jeans:

- **Monday through Thursday:** Solid navy or khaki pants and shorts purchased from FlynnO'Hara are to be worn.
- **Friday:** In addition to approved uniforms, denim jeans may be worn on Fridays only. Jeans are to be solid blue - no other colors are allowed. "Skinny jeans" or overly baggy jeans are not allowed.

All Pants/Shorts/Jeans should not be too tight nor too loose. Clothing should not allow undergarments to be visible. Low-rise garments are not permitted nor is "sagging" allowed. Pants and jeans may not be cut to fit over shoes, and may not have holes, rips or frays. Shorts must not be shorter than three inches above the crease at the back of the knee and not be longer than the bottom of the knee. No cargo/crop/carpenter or cargo style pants/jeans.

Belts: A belt must be worn with garments that have belt loops when a shirt is worn tucked in, when the belt loops are easily seen or when needed to ensure proper fit of shorts or pants even when worn with an untucked shirt. Belts must be solid black, brown, navy blue or tan in color with a regular "D-ring" or other standard buckle (no "logo" buckles). Belts with studs or spikes are not allowed.

Shoes: Athletic or casual shoes, in good condition and properly fitted, should be worn each day. Shoes with laces or lace eyelets must be tied at all times. Flip-flops, sandals, slippers, and boots are not allowed.

Socks: If socks are worn, socks must be matching and visible at the top of the shoe. Acceptable colors are white, navy blue, gray, black or Columbia blue. No images or wording other than manufacturer's marks or logos.

All outerwear garments must be neat in appearance, appropriately sized and worn over approved CCS uniform shirts or clothing. Heavy coats may be worn to and from school and at recess but may not be worn inside buildings. Only navy outerwear may be worn on chapel days.

Co-Curricular: Students attending school-sponsored functions, including home and away activities, are to use the following guidelines for non-uniform attire: 1) The administration may allow or require special clothing to be worn as may be needed or appropriate for a particular field trip or special event; 2) Boys are not permitted to wear tank tops, see-through/mesh clothing or loose-fitting sleeveless shirts, and are expected to wear a shirt unless a coach or faculty member gives permission for particular games or activities and 3) No clothing is allowed that promotes activities/things contrary to school policies and Christian values.

Grooming: Boys are not permitted to body pierce, artificial tattoos, wear make-up or nail polish, body-write or wear pierced or clip-on jewelry (earrings, nose rings, gauges, chains, bars etc.).

Hair: Hair must be neatly groomed at all times. It should be worn in a manner that is not a distraction to the student or others around him (this includes mohawks or any other extreme haircuts and/or extreme contrast or unnatural color). Hair should be worn above the eyebrows and ears, and off the shirt collar in the back. Hairstyles that have hair lengths which cause the student to wet, clip, tie or gel back the hair in order to gain compliance are not acceptable.

Head Gear: No head coverings of any kind (hats, bandanas, hoodies, towels, etc.) are permitted to be worn inside buildings. No combs, sunglasses or picks are to be worn in hair or on the head.
